SPECIFICATION FOR PERSONNEL LICENCES

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, it is desirable to consolidate and modernize the aviation advisory circulars to bring them to international standards,

WHEREAS, it is important to set the directives as to how the regulatory, administrative, technical and supervisory activities of the Authority shall be performed in the one hand and setting the duties, obligations and standards that shall be respected by operators and aviation personnel,

WHEREAS, it is necessary, to provide detailed directives for the administration of licenses, certification, investigation and enforcement of aviation laws.

NOW THEREBY, The Authority under its power given by Article 92/2 of the Civil Aviation Proclamation No. 616/2008 issued the following directives.

1. SHORT TITLE

These directives may be cited as “Advisory Circulars, ECAA-AC-PEL001”

2. REPEAL AND INAPPLICABLE LAWS

No law, directive, order or practice shall, in so far as it is inconsistent with this advisory circular, be applicable with respect to matters provided for by this circular.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This advisory circular shall come into force as of July 1, 2013.

I N T R O D U C T I O N

CAA Advisory Circulars are issued pursuant to the Civil Aviation Proclamation No. 616/2008, by the authority of the Director General and contains rules, instructions, requirements and information pertaining to aircraft operations.

This circular prescribes the specification for personnel licenses. Amendments to these circulars shall be made when necessary and will be provided to all concerned.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR PERSONNEL LICENCES

1. GENERAL

Personnel licences issued in accordance with the relevant provisions of CAA Advisory Circular shall conform to the following specifications:-

1.1 Detail of licences

The following details shall appear on the licence:

- I. Name of state (in bold type)
- II. Title of licence (in very bold type);
- III. Serial number of the licence, in Arabic numerals, given by the authority issuing the licence;
- IV. Name of holder in full (in roman alphabet also if script of national language is other than roman);
 - IV(a) Date of birth;
 - V. Address of holder;
 - VI. Nationality of holder;
 - VIII Authority and, where necessary, conditions under which the licence is issued;
 - XII Certification concerning validity and authorization for holder to exercise privileges appropriate to licence;
 - X Signature of officer issuing the licence and the date of such issue;
 - XI Seal or stamp of authority issuing the licence;
 - XII Ratings, e.g. category, class, type of aircraft, airframe, and aerodrome control. Etc;



- a) Remarks, i.e. special endorsements relating to limitations and endorsements for privileges;
- b) Any other details desired by the state issuing the licence.

1.2 Material of licences

First quality paper or other suitable material shall be used and the items mentioned in 1.1 shown clearly thereon.

1.3 Colour of licences

1.3.1 where the same coloured material is used for all licences issued that colour shall be white

1.3.2 Licences issued carry a distinguishing colour marking, the colours shall be as follows

- a) Private Pilot - aeroplane - Light brown
- b) commercial pilot-aeroplane - light blue
- c) airline transport pilot-aeroplane - dark green
- d) Private Pilot-helicopter - light gray
- e) commercial Pilot-helicopter - dark gray
- f) airline transport pilot-helicopter - two or more dark gray stripes on white background
- g) glider pilot - pink
- h) free balloon pilot - violet
- i) flight navigator - red
- j) flight engineer - brown
- k) aircraft maintenance(technician/engineer/mechanic) - maroon
- l) air traffic controller - yellow
- m) flight operations officer - light green
- n) aeronautical station operator - two or more orange stripes on white background

1.4 Language used

Licenses shall be issued in the English language.

1.5 Arrangement of Items

Item headings on the license shall be uniformly numbered in roman numerals as indicated in 1.1, so that on any license the number will, under any arrangement, refer to the same item heading.
